G.L.P. Program

The Graduated licensing Program (GLP) is a comprehensive classroom oriented and in car lessons consisting of:

- 18 hours of classroom time
- 14 Hours of 1-1 driving lessons (1 hr each lesson)
- You get 2 high school credits (helps with spare blocks)
- 6 months off the class 5 road test.

The classroom is held on weekends from 10-5 pm and is taught by a GLP approved instructor with over 15 years of experience. In the classroom new drivers learn the following:

- Accident Prevention Techniques (APT's) how to prevent an accident, how to drive in winter, rainy, difficult weather/road conditions)
- Videos and in-depth scenarios are provided to help children who learn better with visuals. (Videos of common driving mistakes)
- Emergency braking maneuvers
- Safety pre-trip check up is taught including: Measuring adequate tire pressure, how to perform a tire change, and basic car mechanics prior to travel)
- In addition, students will review of the ICBC driver's handbook where a test is provided to evaluate understanding of road signs and the rules of road.

All of these are aimed at helping new drivers gain the skills and attitudes to become a safe and confident driver.
